Allahu Akbar

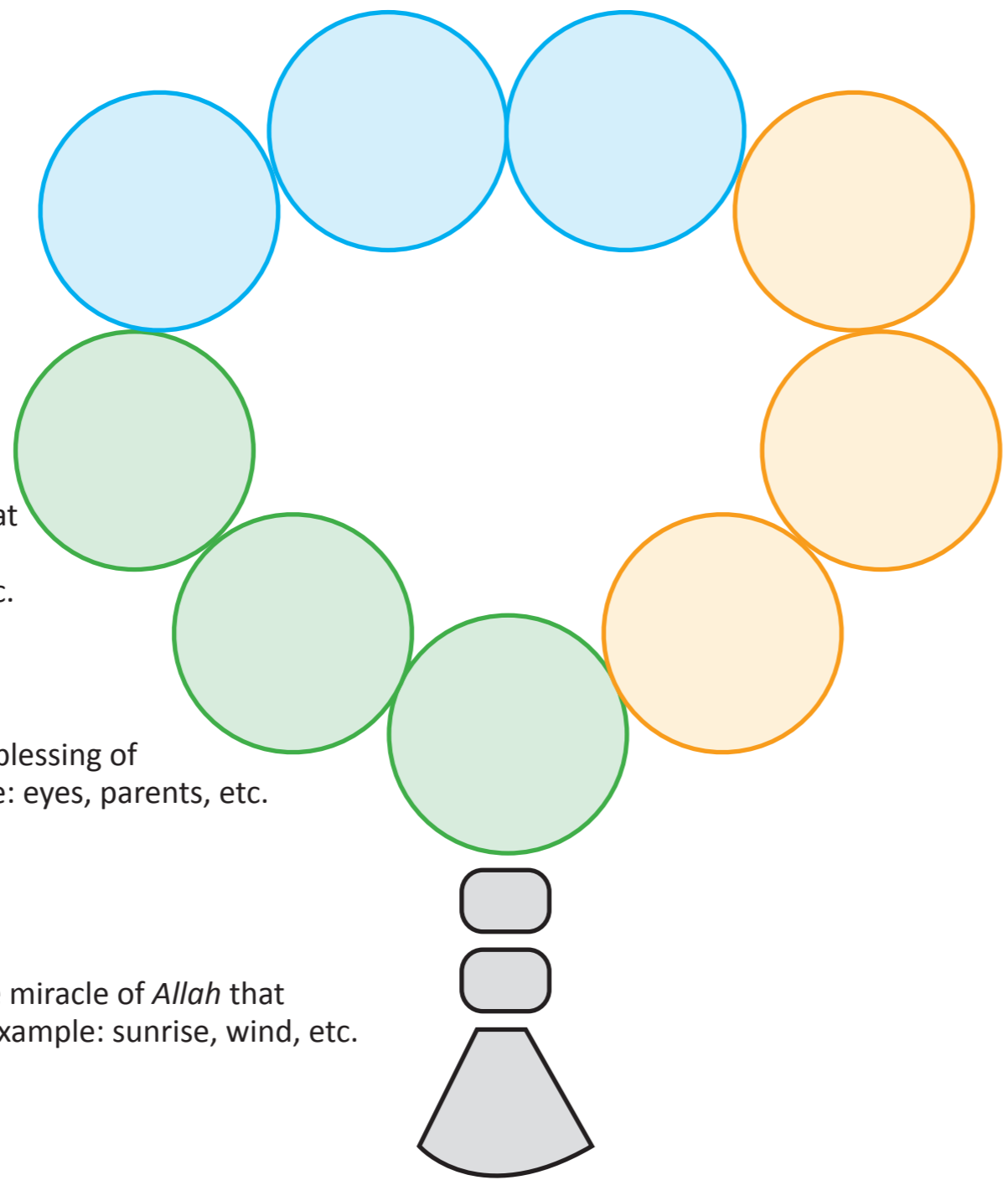
On each blue circle, write one magnificent creation of Allah that remind you of His greatness. For example: mountain, tree, etc.

Allhamdulillah

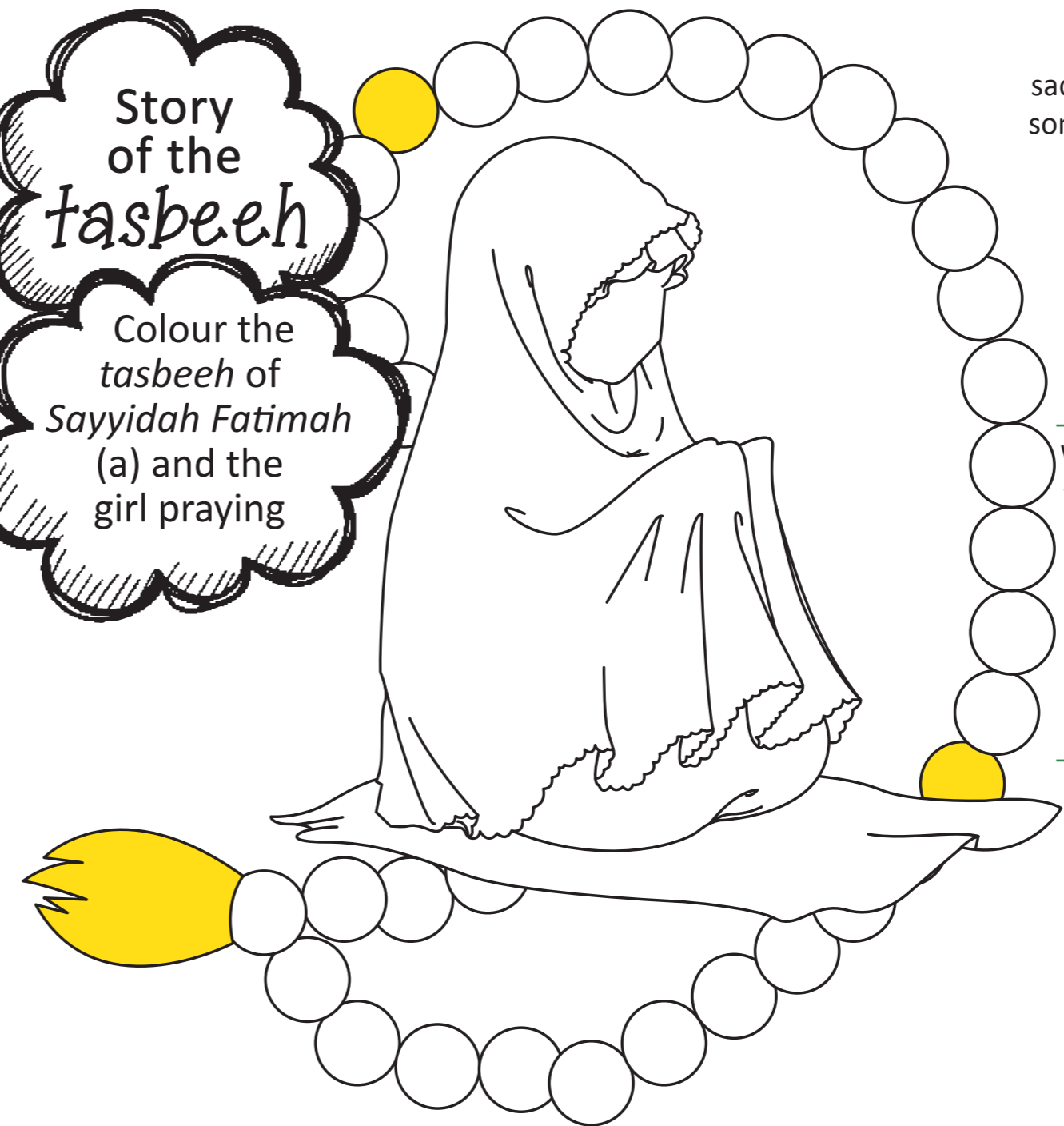
On each green circle, write one blessing of Allah has given you. For example: eyes, parents, etc.

It means "All praise be to Allah."

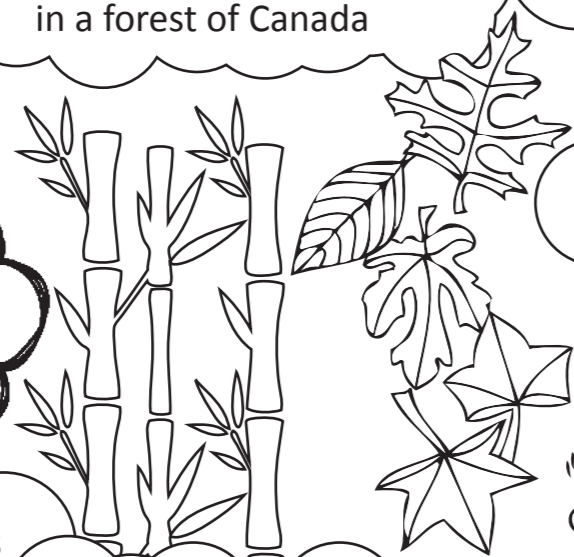
The angels recited

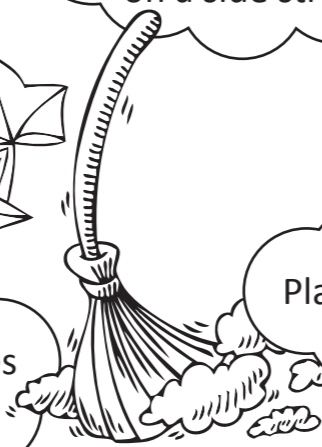
